A Decade of Impact!



What We Do


Each year, we provide 1,000+ services to around 400 individuals, offering

- **Direct Services** - advocacy/support, translation/interpreting, notary, workshops, & resources/referrals
- **RISES (Raising Immigrant Students' Education Success)** - after-school support for Hispanic high/middle schoolers
- **Hispanic Family Therapy** - bilingual psychotherapy (collaboration with CARE Clinic)
- **Emergency Assistance Fund** - short-term, emergency support
- **Hispanic Leadership Program** - fostering leadership/community-building skills (collaboration with Live Healthy Red Wing).
- **Cultural Events & Partnerships**

Spotlight on Two of Our Successes!

RISES (Raising Immigrant Students' Education Success)

Now in its seventh year, RISES supports Red Wing's Hispanic high school and middle school students and their families. Twice-weekly after school, volunteer tutors work with students to help them improve academic skills, earn higher grades, graduate on time, and prepare for post-secondary training/careers. Parental involvement is also strongly promoted. 2015 was a breakthrough year - 4 RISES students enrolled in college!

Hispanic Family Therapy

We were concerned about a desperate need for affordable mental health services in Spanish for local Hispanics. Collaborating with the CARE Clinic, we launched the Hispanic Family Therapy Program in 2015. This short-term therapy with a bilingual/bicultural psychotherapist has filled a huge gap in mental health services. It's still the only such service south of the Twin Cities.

Our services make a big difference!



When I was helpless, Hispanic Outreach had my back. When I slipped on the ice and was laid off, HO was there for me to cushion the fall. They went with me to ask for food stamps and financially helped me with my electricity bills for two months.



I lived my life in fear until I met Hispanic Outreach. I'm a single mother who suffered domestic violence. For years I was victimized at home until a friend of mine talked to me about HO. I needed help to get out of that unhealthy situation. Thanks to their advocacy and resource knowledge I now live a normal life with my little one.
